



## Photography, Audio and Filming Permission Slip #DigilInventorsChallenge virtual bootcamp and virtual final

### Background

The #DigilInventorsChallenge 2021 is a Scottish based competition but for this year we will be running a parallel competition in the UAE, as part of Scotland's contribution to Expo 2020 Dubai which takes place on 31 January and 01 February 2022 and will be delivered in partnership with Heriot Watt University Dubai.

The four finalist Scottish teams will be joined by four UAE finalist teams for our virtual bootcamp in November 2021.

A Scottish Winner and a UAE Winner will then be picked as part of our virtual final which takes place in November 2021.

Both winning teams will have the opportunity to work with our partners to develop a prototype and present their winning ideas as part of Scotland's contribution to Expo 2020 Dubai, which takes place, in Dubai, between 31 January and 01 February 2022 (exact date/ time TBC). This event will be delivered by Scottish Development International.

The Scottish winners will be showcased via live video link or submitting a pre-recorded video during the event. The winners from UAE will (likely) present in person as part of the event although this is dependent on current Covid-19 regulations.

You are a virtual bootcamp and finalist participant in the #DigilInventorsChallenge 2021 which is being led by the Digital Health & Care Innovation Centre (the "DHI") which is currently hosted by the University of Strathclyde.

As the mentor of a team shortlisted in the #DigilInventorsChallenge 2021, you have been invited to participate in:

1. the #DigilInventorsChallenge virtual bootcamp which will take place online using Microsoft Teams on Wednesday 03 November 2021 and Thursday 04 November 2021
2. the #DigilInventorsChallenge virtual final which will take place online using Microsoft Teams on Monday 29 November 2021

The University of Strathclyde, acting through the DHI, would like to record (film and audio) and photograph you participating in the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp, for the purposes described below, and requests your permission to do so.

### What is personal data?

Personal data is any information whatsoever which can be used to identify an individual. Photographs, film and audio recordings of an individual are classed as personal data and consent is needed from that individual to allow others to record, use and share such information.

#### **Why is the DHI collecting your personal data?**

The DHI has requested each finalist team which is to attend the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp to submit their own high-resolution team photograph (to include all team members and their mentor) to be used alongside any press and promotional work to promote the #DigilInventorsChallenge 2021.

The DHI's internal marketing team also intend to capture photographs, film and audio record the participants in the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp, and from whom the DHI has obtained the necessary permission, to promote the #DigilInventorsChallenge 2021. The DHI may also engage a third-party supplier to capture photographs, film and audio record at the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp. The University of Strathclyde will ensure that they own all copyright in the photographs, audio recordings and films (including those captured by any third-party supplier) produced as part of this exercise.

#### **How will the DHI use your personal data and who will they share it with?**

If you are willing to provide consent the DHI would like to use your photo, name, image, voice or likeness for the following purposes:

- 1) Promotion of the #DigilInventorsChallenge by the DHI for the current and future challenges. Such promotion may include use in the DHI's advertising and resources in relation to the #DigilInventorsChallenge including but not limited to the #DigilInventorsChallenge website ([www.digiinventors.com](http://www.digiinventors.com)), social media, advertising, press, film and video, radio and publications.
- 2) Video images of the participants presenting the subject matter of their competition entries at the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp may be shared with judges for judging purposes.
- 3) To create videos for the winners' presentation at a pre-determined formal prize-giving event (yet to be confirmed) and to be shown online on the DHI website.
- 4) Use on #DigilInventorsChallenge partner and sponsor organisation websites and resources for the purposes of promoting and advertising the #DigilInventorsChallenge. Such partners include but may not be limited to Digital Health & Care Innovation Centre, Glasgow Warriors, dressCode, Heriot Watt University Dubai, Scottish Edge, Scottish Tech Army, Orcha, Scottish Development International, Scottish Enterprise, a Dubai related organisation (TBC).

#### **Consent**

I consent to the University of Strathclyde (DHI) using photographs and/or video recordings including images of me as described above.
