



#DigiInventors Challenge 2024 – Primary School Edition

Photography, Audio and Filming Permission Slip

Background

The #DigiInventors Challenge, Primary School Edition, challenges Scotland's Primary School pupilss to work either as an individual, in pairs or in teams (of up to a maximum of 4 pupils) and come up with a digital health and care idea that can help young people live fitter, healthier and happier lives.

It is a digital challenge whereby digital submissions will be reviewed and judged, before a winner and plus runners up, for each stage (Primary 5, Primary 6 and Primary 7) will be invited to attend an in-person award ceremony and prizegiving at the City of Glasgow College.

What is personal data?
