



Photography, Audio and Filming Permission Slip #DigilInventorsChallenge hybrid bootcamp and final 2022

Background

The #DigilInventorsChallenge 2022 is a Scottish based Competition which has now gone global as DHI now runs a parallel competition aimed at secondary school pupils in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). The UAE Competition will be delivered by the DHI's partner, the Heriot Watt University Dubai.

Four finalist Scottish teams will be invited to meet with the DHI at the City of Glasgow College. At the same time, four finalist UAE teams will be invited to meet representatives of the Heriot Watt University Dubai in the UAE. The eight teams will participate in a virtual (using Microsoft Teams) "hybrid" bootcamp on 7 & 8 November 2022

The four finalist Scottish teams will then be invited to meet with the DHI at the City of Glasgow College. At the same time, four finalist UAE teams will be invited to meeting with representatives of the Heriot Watt University Dubai in the UAE. The eight teams will then participate in a virtual (using Microsoft Teams) "hybrid" final on 6 December 2022. A Scottish winner and a UAE winner will then be selected & announced on 7 December 2022.

Both winning teams will have the opportunity to work with selected DigilInventorsChallenge partners to develop a prototype and present their winning ideas at in-person prize giving events (which may be linked using Microsoft Teams) which shall take place on 30/ 31 January 2023.

Each of the respective winning teams will present in-person in Scotland or the UAE with their presentation either being live streamed or pre-recorded and shared at the other prize giving ceremony.

You are a virtual bootcamp and finalist participant in the #DigilInventorsChallenge 2022 which is being led by the Digital Health & Care Innovation Centre (the "DHI") which is currently hosted by the University of Strathclyde.

As the mentor of a team shortlisted in the #DigilInventorsChallenge 2022, you have been invited to participate in:

1. the #DigilInventorsChallenge hybrid bootcamp which will take place in person and online using Microsoft Teams on 07 November 2022 and 08 November 2022
2. the #DigilInventorsChallenge virtual final which will take place in person and online using Microsoft Teams on 06 December 2022

The University of Strathclyde, acting through the DHI, would like to record (film and audio) and photograph you participating in the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp, for the purposes described below, and requests your permission to do so.

What is personal data?

Personal data is any information whatsoever which can be used to identify an individual. Photographs, film and audio recordings of an individual are classed as personal data and consent is needed from that individual to allow others to record, use and share such information.

Why is the DHI collecting your personal data?

The DHI has requested each finalist team which is to attend the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp to submit their own high-resolution team photograph (to include all team members and their mentor) to be used alongside any press and promotional work to promote the #DigilInventorsChallenge 2022.

The DHI's internal marketing team also intend to capture photographs, film and audio record the participants in the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp, and from whom the DHI has obtained the necessary permission, to promote the #DigilInventorsChallenge 2022. The DHI may also engage a third-party supplier to capture photographs, film and audio record at the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp. The University of Strathclyde will ensure that they own all copyright in the photographs, audio recordings and films (including those captured by any third-party supplier) produced as part of this exercise.

How will the DHI use your personal data and who will they share it with?

If you are willing to provide consent the DHI would like to use your photo, name, image, voice or likeness for the following purposes:

- 1) Promotion of the #DigilInventorsChallenge by the DHI for the current and future challenges. Such promotion may include use in the DHI's advertising and resources in relation to the #DigilInventorsChallenge including but not limited to the #DigilInventorsChallenge website (www.digiinventors.com), social media, advertising, press, film and video, radio and publications.
- 2) Video images of the participants presenting the subject matter of their competition entries at the #DigilInventorsChallenge bootcamp may be shared with judges for judging purposes.
- 3) To create videos for the winners' presentation at a pre-determined formal prize-giving event (yet to be confirmed) and to be shown online on the DHI website.
- 4) Use on #DigilInventorsChallenge partner and sponsor organisation websites and resources for the purposes of promoting and advertising the #DigilInventorsChallenge. Such partners include but may not be limited to Digital Health & Care Innovation Centre, Glasgow Warriors, dressCode, Heriot Watt University Dubai, City of Glasgow College, Scottish Edge, Scottish Tech Army, Orcha, Scottish Development International and Scottish Enterprise.

Consent

I consent to the University of Strathclyde (DHI) using photographs and/or video recordings including images of me as described above.

The University retains the right to share materials with third parties to enable us to promote the University /DHI.
